



Official Statement from the Precision Rifle Series

Date: November 4, 2025

Integrity and fairness are the foundation of the Precision Rifle Series. Every competitor, match director, and sponsor depends on the honesty of our scoring to ensure that competition outcomes are earned on the range, never manipulated off the range.

At the 2025 Pro Series Finale, a fellow competitor raised concerns that match scores may have been altered after submission. PRS officials immediately initiated a review, which confirmed that a member of the PRS community, who also held administrative access to the scoring system, had modified their personal match results for competitive advantage.

Upon discovery, PRS leadership acted swiftly. The falsified results were removed, standings were corrected, and disciplinary measures were issued in accordance with PRS rules and governance policies:

- The individual has been **suspended from PRS competition for one year.**
- They have received a **lifetime ban from serving as a PRS Match Director or Regional Director.**
- They have received a **lifetime ban from scoring competitors at matches or any scoring solutions for matches.**

Additionally, PRS has implemented enhanced system safeguards, independent audit reviews, and stricter administrative access protocols to ensure this type of activity cannot occur again.

While this situation is disappointing, it also underscores the strength and integrity of the PRS community. We thank the competitor who brought forward their concerns and reaffirm our commitment to transparency, accountability, and fair competition for all.

The Precision Rifle Series remains dedicated to protecting the integrity of our sport and ensuring that every competitor earns their results on the range, through skill, not cheating.
