The product family consists of two models: ZEISS LRP S₃ 425-50 and 6₃6-56. Both are available in either milliradian (MRAD) or minute-of-angle (MOA) configurations. PRS shooters are impressed by the total elevation travel – for precise bullet placement on the most distant targets. With up to 160 MOA or 46.5 MRAD of total elevation travel for the 425-50 model and 110 MOA or 32 MRAD for the 636-56 model, the LRP S3 ensures the bullet impact even on the most distant targets.

The ZEISS LRP S₃ coupled with the all-new ZEISS LRP S₅ provides a PRS product lineup of high-performance optics, featuring best-in-class total elevation travel, and highly repeatable, precise, and tactile turrets as part of compact and heavy-duty riflescopes built for competition. The ZEISS LRP S₅ is designed, engineered, and manufactured in Germany and is built to withstand up to a massive 1,500 g-force of recoil. The ZEISS LRP S₅ product family consists of two models: 318-50 and 525-56 and is available in four unique configurations – all with 34 mm main tubes.

"For longer-range shooting, precision is crucial.
